2120 B.C.E. God calls Abram (later Abraham) to go to the land of Canaan.
The time of the Patriarchs begins.

1906 B.C.E. Jacob and his sons go to Egypt.

1836 B.C.E. Joseph dies in Egypt.

912 B.C.E. Elijah begins to prophesy.

- 896 B.C.E. Elijah is taken up to heaven.
721 B.C.E. Assyrians conquer Israel and take ten tribes into captivity.
705 B.C.E. Traditional date of the events in the book of Tobit.
